Health insurance coverage:

Insurance coverage for nutrition therapy by private insurance and Medicaid plans if varied. Many health plans will offer some coverage for nutrition counseling. Depending on your insurance plan, you may be able to receive nutrition counseling services at no cost to you. Before scheduling an appointment, contact your insurance company to verify coverage for medical nutrition therapy.

Sliding Fee Discount Program:

We also offer a Sliding Fee Discount Program to provide low-cost nutrition services. This is available to all patients who qualify based on their annual household income and family size even if they have insurance..

How to schedule an appointment:
